Currently, she is a co-Principal Investigator on 2 research projects funded by the Institute of Education Sciences, U.S. Department of Education and a co-Principal Investigator for an Equity Assistance Center (Region VIII). To date she has authored or co-authored almost 100 articles, books, and book chapters. In 2004 she won the American Educational Research Association's Early Career Award.
